Dear Friends and Supporters,

We are very grateful for your prayer and financial support over the last few months. We know that in these times of accelerating inflation and economic uncertainty, the temptation can be to react out of fear. Thank you again for your faithfulness to the cause of Christ.

MINISTRY: Since our last prayer letter, we have seen some good spiritual growth among the believers, especially evidenced during our weekly discipleship groups and Sunday afternoon discussions and fellowship times. We have also seen several invited visitors attend and some have returned for multiple services. Most of the visitors are of course lost but were invited by church members who are their colleagues. Our Wednesday night prayer meeting is seeing some increased attendance

as well. As in every ministry, we have times of watching people turn away from the Lord and that is always difficult.

I attended a seminar over the last reporting period that was refreshing in the area of soulwinning and explaining the Gospel. The seminar was especially helpful in providing some tools for assessing whether someone has a Biblical understanding of the Gospel and how to take them from where they are to where they need to be in their understanding. As I have shared before, much of the Bible's key concepts are read with a different dictionary in the Thai/folk Buddhist setting. While they talk of God, sin, spirit/soul, heaven and hell, they mean something completely different.

We have continued with soulwinning campaigns on Facebook. Since the beginning of July, over 50,000 people in the city of Phitsanulok saw the ad for our video on the definition of sin, and over 38,000 people took the time to watch it. We also did a Gospel campaign geared more to children and young people. This Gospel video is a cartoon presentation of the Gospel. Over 38,000 people saw this ad, and over 13,000 people took the time to watch it.

Some of you may have seen the news story on the horrific nursery school massacre that occurred in Nong Bua Lam Poo. That city is approximately five hours to the east of us, but there is no Baptist Church of any kind in that city. We chose to run a 'Creation to Christ' ad in that city for the two weeks following the massacre. This video is a 20-minute presentation clearly explaining the Gospel. Over 20,000 people in the city of Nong Bua Lam Poo saw the ad for the video, and over 7,000 people took the time to watch it. Please continue to pray with us for these many seeds that have been planted. We trust that His Word will not return unto Him void.
