As I write this, we have been back in Thailand for just over 1 month! Where has the time gone! The 3 months that we were back in North America flew by in a blur of time with family and friends, reporting to supporting churches, meetings with new churches, taking care of government paperwork, banking, insurance, and health related appointments! Thank you for praying for us during that time AND for our return travels as well.

Some things from our time in North America that we are praising the Lord about include...

- We were able to spend some great time with Jessica and Wayne! (And other family and friends as well!)
- Safety in traveling. Since the beginning of September to the 17th of October, I drove over 15,000Kms (9,500 miles) in a vehicle that a young couple in our home church graciously loaned to us.
- We've had a couple of new churches already vote to take us on for support in 2024, with a couple of others saying they will be taking us on for support in the future as well.
- Maureen was able to visit a chiropractic doctor, and this has greatly helped reduce her pain levels in her back (Scoliosis). She was also experiencing some extreme nerve pain that the doctor was able to diagnose the cause of and give treatment that has been very affective!
- Wyatt has a new passport, but since they send the old passport back separately from the new one, he had to come back to Thailand separately at the end of November.
- Upon arrival at the Airport Immigration in Bangkok, there was no issue having Wyatt's visa transferred into his new passport.

During our time away there were several praiseworthy items from the ministry as well...

- A lady who began attending at the beginning of May put her trust in the Lord for salvation.
- The unsaved 84 year old father of one of the members began attending and listening attentively since the middle of October.
