Dear Praying Friends and Supporters,

"I thank my God...for your fellowship in the gospel from the first day until now;" - Phil. 1:3-5.

I wanted to take this update and just say a special thank you to those who have given to the printing of materials over the last couple of years! We have printed the teachers and students' books called "Foundations for the Family." There is a great need for a Biblical understanding of what a family is and how to have a family that is honoring to God.

Another missionary family did the hard work of translating and one of our church ladies helped in the proofreading of the books. Maureen put appropriate illustrations in the text and laid it out for printing.

At the beginning of October we were able to attend a fellowship meeting in Bangkok with other Independent Baptists pastors and missionaries from across Thailand. During one of the discussion sessions, I was able to present the finished books to those attending, and we pray that the Lord will use them to help strengthen the local churches.

Thank you also for those who remembered Charity on her birthday this month! She has been a great blessing to our household over the last 16 years and we joy over the godly young lady that she is becoming. She is active in serving the Lord every week with music, the sound/media ministry on Sundays and nursery duties!

We have had a couple of visitors to church during this school term break, and promoted a digital copy of the Chick tract "This Is Your Life" in social media during special events that were held in the city. Over 275,000 people had the opportunity to read through the tract during the months of August through October. Over 26,000 people stopped to read at least a portion of the tract. We are praying for fruit from this outreach.

On October 26th, it was announced that the 93-year-old Queen Mother of Thailand had passed away. The announcement commenced the official mourning period of one year across the nation. This means certain events and celebrations will be either cancelled or modified to be less celebratory in nature. It also means a dress code of black, white, or at least, "muted" colors for the next year.

Pray especially for the salvation of the Thai people who are being confronted with the mortality that all people must face. Pray especially for Neung, More, Hua, and the families of our church members.
